Alex City Recycling Receives Grant

Every year ADEM (Alabama Department of Environmental Management) administers grant funds to recycling facilities throughout the state to support the purchase of infrastructure, equipment, education and outreach efforts. The funds were made available through the Solid Wastes & Recyclable Materials Management Act (SWRMMA) that the Alabama Legislature passed in 2008.

This year ADEM received over \$3 million in requested grant money.

ADEM awarded the Alexander City Recycling Facility \$56,890.00 to purchase a new and more efficient baler.

The funds will cover the cost of a new baler. The current baler will only bale cardboard and is extremely slow. The new baler will allow city employees to bale cardboard, plastics (1 & 2), tin cans and aluminum cans more efficiently.
