

In compliance with the Department of Transportation, Pipeline Safety Regulations, Part 192.16 Customer- Owned Service Lines, Customer Notification, the Alexander City Gas Department issues the following notice:

-----NOTICE-----

- The Alexander City Gas Department does not maintain customer piping beyond the natural gas meter.
- If the customer's piping is not maintained it may be subject to potential hazards of corrosion and leakage.
- Customers buried gas piping beyond the natural gas meter should be:
 1. Periodically inspected for leaks
 2. Periodically inspected for corrosion if the piping is metallic
 3. Repaired if any unsafe condition is discovered
- When excavating near buried gas piping, the piping should be located two (2) working days in advance, and the excavation done by hand.
- Local plumbers and heating contractors can assist in locating, inspecting, and repairing the customer's buried piping.

The City of Alexander City's policy on customer piping has not changed. Any damage or leaking pipe downstream of the meter is your responsibility. The Gas Department will be glad to assist you in turning the gas off at the meter if you have an emergency.
