General Information and Rules –Both Adult Divisions:

Eligibility: Local artists who live, work, attend school or college in Alexander City are eligible to enter this exhibit.

Number Of Entries: There is a limit of **two (2)** entries per artist.

FEE: \$1.00 Fee per entry

Works Eligible:

1. Works submitted must be original works of art and must not have been exhibited previously in the **LIBRARY ART SHOW**.
2. Works may be submitted in two-dimensional graphic media (paintings-drawings-prints). All works must be dry and suitably framed with a wire attached to the back for hanging. **NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS.** Gallery wrapped paintings will be accepted if canvas works are suitable for presentation (painted sides on heavy duty stretcher bars). Drawings and prints should be matted (preferably under glass) and fixed properly for hanging.
3. Due to space limitations we cannot accept works larger than **36" X 48"**, and we cannot accept crafts, sculpture, photography, etc.
4. Artist's name, address, title of work and medium should be on back of work. Artist's **AGE** in **YOUNG ADULT DIVISION** should be included.

Return of Works: The show will be on display at the library through **April 30th**. Please pick up your paintings on **Thursday or Friday, May 1st and May 2nd**. Award winning works will be exhibited at our local banks after **May 2nd**.

General Information And Rules

Eligibility: LOCAL ARTISTS WITHIN THE AGES OF 6 & 13 WHO LIVE IN ALEXANDER CITY, OR ATTEND SCHOOL IN ALEXANDER CITY.

Number of Entries: **Each artist will be allowed ONLY ONE WORK** ORIGINAL WORKS ONLY ON ART PAPER OR CANVAS AND MUST BE FRAMED AND MUST NOT HAVE BEEN EXHIBITED PREVIOUSLY IN THE LIBRARY ART SHOWS. **WE WILL ONLY ACCEPT FRAMED WORKS WITH WIRE ATTACHED TO BACK FOR HANGING.**

IMPORTANT NOTE: YOUR NAME, AGE, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER, TITLE OF WORK AND MEDIUM MUST BE ON THE BACK OF YOUR WORK.

AWARDS:
FIRST, SECOND, THIRD PLACE RIBBONS AWARDED FOR EACH AGE GROUP.

RECEIVING DATES FOR THE JUVENILE DIVISION:

Registration for the JUVENILE DIVISION is a week earlier than for the ADULT divisions. Entries will be received on the ground floor of the Adelia M. Russell Library for registration on the following dates:
