## STATEMENT:

The City of Alexander City is planning for the replacement of a culvert underneath Worthy Road. The culvert, which is underneath Worthy Road between Worthy Place and Airport Drive, has deteriorated over the years and is in danger of failure. The City is asking the residents of Worthy Road for patience and extreme caution while driving in the area of the project during this construction period.

Weather permitting, the Street Department will begin actual construction on Monday, December 5, 2011. It is anticipated that the construction could take as long as two weeks from the start for work to be completed. PLEASE BE AWARE THAT WORTHY ROAD WILL BE COMPLETELY CLOSED DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PERIOD. Residents in this area as well as those that use the road as a cut-through will be required to find alternate routes that do not involve this section of Worthy Road. However, residents adjacent to the work area will be able to access their driveways during this process.

Please plan your alternate routes and prepare for the possibility of short delays. The City would like to thank you in advance for your patience over the next few weeks in helping us make this a safe and successful project.
