Requirements for Licensing & Permitting New Commercial, Additions, or Repairs:

- 1. All contracted work, materials and labor in the amount of \$1,000.00 and over requires a permit. Electrical, Plumbing, & Heating & Air contractors must be State certified. All companies performing work or providing services must have a City license. Companies delivering products must have City license. Common carriers are exempt from this requirement.
- 2. All building plans for a new construction shall be submitted to the Building Department two (2) days before a building application is approved for permit issuance. Two sets of plans are a requirement if the construction is over 2,500 square feet. (2 civil) (2 sets of building plans) signed by an engineer/architect as applicable. The Building Official will arrange a pre-construction meeting if requested by the owner/contractor or hired general contractor.
- 3. Contractors performing contract work over \$50,000.00 must comply with Title 34; Chapter 8; Section I-22 Code of Alabama.
- 4. A City of Alexander City current Business License is required for: hired General Contractors and all Subcontractors. (Plumbing, Electric, and Heating & Air subcontractors must present their State of Alabama G.C. License if contract work is \$50,000.00 and over, when applying for a City Business License and/or Permitting a project.) Special note: Sub General Contractor cannot work under Owner/Contractor, must be a General Contractor, not a Sub. Sub General Contractor can work under a hired General Contractor.
- 5. All contractors must present proof of General Liability Insurance to the Building Department in the amount of \$100,000.00 before a permit is issued when the contract/permit amount exceeds \$10,000.00 or any plumbing, electrical or mechanical shall also file proof.
- 6. Mechanical/HVAC service work does not require a mechanical permit; however, all other requirement do apply— State License, City Business License, General Liability Insurance.
- 7. All building expansion shall meet storm water and zoning requirements.
- 8. All required inspections shall be scheduled through the Building Department Administrative Assistant (phone number listed above.) Required inspections are listed under "Building Department Guidelines," provided in the New Construction packet.
