Did You Know?

- ◆ The Alexander City Recycling Facility is open for drop offs 24 hours a day/7 days a week and available to everyone in Alexander City and surrounding areas.
- ◆ All plastics have a triangle icon with a number that indicates whether it is #1 or #2 plastic.
- ◆ #1 Plastics are recycled into bottles, carpeting, tennis balls, insulation for jackets, t-shirts, paint brushes, etc.
- ◆ #2 Plastics are recycled into lumber substitute, detergent and bleach bottles, trash cans, buckets, toys, traffic barriers, fly swatters, etc.
- ◆ The Electronics Recycling Event is held the second Thursday of each month at the Public Works Recycling Facility. All electronics are free to recycle. We can no longer accept CRT televisions and monitors for recycling.
